<sup>(1)</sup> **GMAT** and **TOEFL** are highly recommended. They are not compulsory to be considered in the application procedure, except for business engineering (see below at <sup>(2)</sup>). You can provide alternative certificate(s) or proofs but it is advised to provide the recommended ones. If your academic background demonstrates proficiency in English or in Quantitative Techniques, it may not be necessary to provide results for the related test.

<sup>(2)</sup> **12 credits in sciences** : To access the Master in Business Engineering, at least 12 credits of courses in sciences (physics, chemistry) are required in the Bachelor programme. However, applicants with a Bachelor programme not including 12 credits of science may be considered if they fulfil all of the following criteria:

- they have completed their Bachelor degree in the top quartile of their class (equivalent to a Grade of B <sup>(3)</sup>)
- they obtained a GMAT score of at least 650
- they demonstrate full proficiency in English (i.e. through a TOEFL score > 95)
- they have a strong background in the main management disciplines: accounting, finance, marketing, HRM, etc.

<sup>(4)</sup> Applicants with a Bachelor degree in *Handelsingenieur* from the *Vlaamse Gemeenschap* are not required to provide GMAT and TOEFL.
